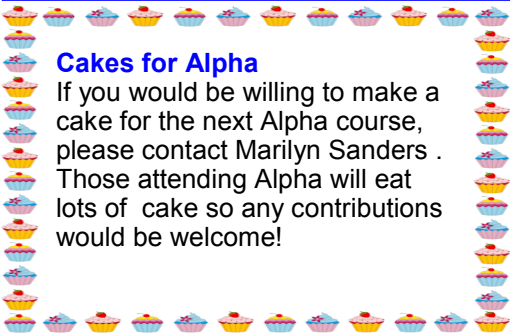
Electoral Roll and Annual Parochial Church Meeting
