### Justyn Rees Larcombe

Justyn Rees Larcombe is coming to Trinity on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. He is the son of the writer and speaker Jennifer Rees Larcombe and grandson of the evangelist Tom Rees. After a highly successful career in the British Army Justyn Rees Larcombe had an equally glittering and well rewarded career in the City. He had everything. Stunningly successful in the world of insurance, he was being fast tracked for further promotion in a global company. He had wealth, a big house, a Porsche, and a Mercedes. He had a beautiful wife and three sons. He lost it all through an addiction to online gambling, including losing £750,000 in three years. Realising he could fall no further, he turned back to Christ, turned his back on gambling and, in the space of two years, found incredible recovery and restoration.

He will be telling his story here at 7.30pm on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, and this will be a great evening to invite non - Christians to. Admission is free.
