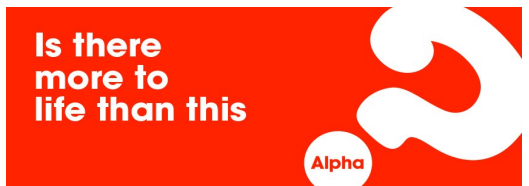
Marriage Course
