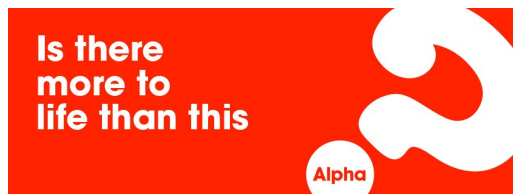
Alpha starting
