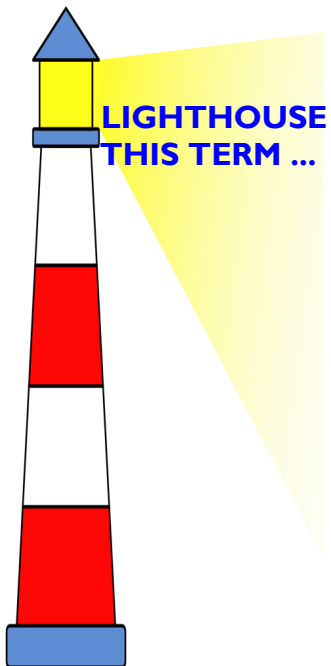


Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life."

We are collecting food items to support Barnstaple's Foodbank Please find below a list of particular needs for the Food Bank. Donations can be brought up to the front before the service or during the service. Chopped tinned tomatoes, baked beans, tinned meat and fish, Tinned soup Dried herbs and spices, tinned pulses, rice and cous cous Sugar, custard, rice pudding, tinned fruit (not grapefruit)

Coffee, cocoa, instant chocolate drink, fruit squash (not tea) Baking ingredients – dried fruit, baking powder, vanilla essence, chocolate Brown sauce, tomato sauce, mayonnaise, pepper Non-bio washing powder, washing-up liquid, kitchen rolls Toilet rolls, shower gel, shampoo, kitchen roll, hand wash.
